Guidelines for Award of Moderation marks

- Moderation of maximum 5 marks is given to each semester to cover <u>all the</u>
 <u>theory subjects</u> appeared by the students for the Regular and Supplementary
 Examinations.
- 2. Moderation marks will be given only to the subject requires passing minimum marks (Terminal Examination and Total Marks) as specified in the curriculum and not for the improvement of Grade obtained.
- 3. Award of such moderation marks will be added only to the Terminal Examination marks, not in the Continuous Assessment Marks.
- 4. While allotting moderation marks, the subject(s) require less moderation marks will be given priority.
- 5. If the external marks obtained are same in two subjects (less than passing minimum) among the subjects in a semester, for allotting moderation marks the subject(s) having more internal marks will be given priority. If again, the internal marks are same in both the subjects, the allocation of moderation marks goes as per the subject order listed in the curriculum of the respective semester/degree programme.
- 6. Sl.No. 4 and 5 are repeated as long as the available moderation marks can be used for making 'passes'.
- 7. During the allocation of marks, if any subjects need moderation marks more than the balance available in the semester, moderation marks will not be given.
- 8. Any balance moderation marks available in a semester will not be carried over to next semester.
