1. ENGLISH ESSAY:

- Any number of participants from each school is allowed.
- Time duration - 1 hour.

2. TAMIL ESSAY:

- Any number of participants from each school is allowed.
- Time duration - 1 hour.

- Only two (for each group) entries from each school are allowed.
- Time duration: 3 minutes.
- Participants are allowed to participate at any time within the allotted duration.

5. TAMIL STORY TELLING:

- Only two entries from each school is allowed.

- Time duration – 3 minutes.
- Participants are allowed to participate any time within the allocated duration.
- Participants should be upto **third standard**.

6. TAMIL STORY TO PROVERB:

- Only two entries from each school is allowed.
- Time duration – 3 minutes.
- Proverb will be given on the spot.
- Participants must narrate a story only related to the proverb.

FUN EVENTS:

1. POT POURRI:

(Visual Teasers, Maathi yosi)

- Only two teams per school are allowed to perform.
- Maximum 3 per team.
- Other rules will be announced on the spot.
- This is a preliminary event for dumb charades.

Dumb Charades:

- Selected teams from the above two rounds are allowed to participate.
- Other rules will be announced on the spot.

2. REWIND MEMORY:

- Two persons per school are allowed to participate.
- Other rules will be announced on the spot.

MUSIC EVENTS:

SINGING(SOLO)

Each pair of participants can participate either in general or folk

1. General

- Time: 4 minutes
- Only two students from each groups(GROUP A & B) ,per school are allowed to participate
- The song selection might be chosen from films or any other.
- Special points will be given for songs related to our theme.

2. Folk

- Time: 4 minutes.
- Only two students from each group (GROUP 1&2) ,per school are allowed to participate.
- Songs must not be from any cinema.
- Special points will be given for songs related to our theme.

3. INSTRUMENTAL (SOLO)

- Please do bring your instruments.
- Only two students from each group(GROUP A&B) ,per school are allowed to participate.
- Time : 4+1 minutes.
- Participants are allowed to participate any time within the allocated duration.
- More points will be given for village based innovative instruments.

ART EVENTS:

1. PAINTING:

- Time: 1 hour.
- Topic will be announced on the spot and it will be related to the theme.
- Only two students from each group(GROUP A&B), per school are allowed to participate.
- Participants should bring their own sets of colours and brushes.
- Charts will be provided.

2. PENCIL SKETCHING:

- Time: 1 hour.
- Topic will be announced on the spot and it will be related to the theme
- Only two students from each group(GROUP A&B) per school are allowed to participate.
- Participants should bring their own materials for sketching (pencils,erasers,etc).
- Charts will be provided.

3. RANGOLI:

- Rangoli should be based on the theme.
- Maximum 4 per team.
- Time:90 minutes.
- The size of the rangoli should be strictly in between 4 feet by 4 feet and 5 feet by 5 feet.
- Participants should bring their own set of colours.

4. CARVING:

- (III) Time : 90 minutes.
- (IV) Only two persons per school are allowed to participate.
- (V) Any type of carving can be done.
- (VI) Participants should bring soap or vegetables or fruits or other materials needed.

5. ART FROM WASTE:

- Time : 90 minutes.
- Maximum 2 per team.
- Only two students per school are allowed to participate.
- Materials will be provided by us.

6. COLLAGE:

- Time 90 minutes.
- There can be two teams per school and two members per team.
- The collage is to be made from materials like news papers, magazines , etc.
- Only a chart and a tube of gum will be given.

7. MEHANDHI

- Time : 45 minutes.
- Two teams per school are allowed to participate.
- Two members per team is allowed(including the designer and design bearer).
- It should be related to the theme.
- Participants should bring their own needed materials.

8. CLOTH DESIGNING:

- Time : 45 minutes.
- Topics will be announced on the spot and would be theme related.
- Cloth will be provided by us.
- All the necessary items for cloth designing are to be brought by the students.

- The designing of the cloth should be innovative.

ONSTAGE EVENTS:

1. DANCE(SOLO)

- Properties can be used in connection with theme.
- 4 minutes of time for each individual (including 30 seconds for stage setup).
- Points will be awarded for the choreography, dancer's performance, expressions, properties used etc.
- Only two persons per school are allowed to participate.
- Proper dress sense should be there.
- Room will be provided for dress change.
- Vulgarity in both songs and costumes are strictly prohibited.
- Cinema songs are strictly prohibited or if used should be theme based.
- Participants are allowed to participate any time within the allocated duration.

2. DANCE(GROUP)

- 5 minutes of time for each individual team (including 30 seconds for stage setup).
- Points will be awarded for the choreography, dancer's performance, facial expressions, properties used, group's synchronization etc.
- Number of students per team should be 4-8.
- Only one team per school is allowed to participate.
- Room will be provided for dress change.
- Vulgarity in both songs and costumes are strictly prohibited.
- Participants are allowed to participate any time within the allocated duration.
- Cinema songs are strictly prohibited or if used should be theme based.

3. VARIETY:

- It should be based on the theme.
- Only one team per school is allowed to participate.
- Maximum number of students per team is 10.
- Each team will get 10 minutes to perform.
- Room will be provided for dress change.

4. AD MAD

- Only one team per school is allowed to participate.
- Maximum number of students per team is 6.
- Product will be announced 10 minutes before the respective slot.
- Each team will get 4 minutes to perform and 1 minute for questions.

5. ARATTAI ARANGAM

- Maximum number of students per school is 1.
- Topic will be given on the spot.
- Rules for this event will be announced on the day of the event.
- Prelims will be conducted before the final round.

6. QUIZ

- Maximum 2 teams per school are allowed.
- Maximum number of students per team is 2.
- Questions will be in both Tamil and English.
- Prelims will be conducted before the final round.

SPECIAL EVENTS:

CROSS WORD/TAMIL PUZZLES/SUDOKU/MATHS EVENT

- All these events will be conducted throughout the day in stalls.
- The rules and duration for solving will be announced on the spot.
- It's open to all. Participants who have taken part in more than two events are also allowed to participate in this event.

TREASURE HUNT:

- 2 per team and a single team per school are allowed.
- Prelims would be a theme related quiz.
- Other rules for the finals will be announced on the spot.

FANCY DRESS:

- Any number of entries from each is school.
- Only students below third standard can participate.
- Dress should be theme based .

DESIGN QUOTIENT:

- 2 participants per team and one team per school are allowed.
- Materials will be provided on the spot to the team and they have to develop a project related to the theme.
- The projects must be made only from the materials provided.
- Time : 60 minutes.
