**Key Discussions and Decisions:**

The Principal extended a formal welcome to all the members.

**1. HRApp Demonstration:**

The registrar demonstrated the leave approval process for faculty and staff in HRApp.

**2. First Semester CAT 1 Result Analysis:**

- Dean (Students) presented the results analysis of Continuous Assessment Test .
- It is observed that 186 students failed in 22MA111 Calculus for Engineers and 125 students failed in 22EG140 Technical English courses. HoD Mathematics is instructed to take appropriate measure to minimize the arrear in continuous assessment tests.
- HoDs are requested to follow up with students who got arrears in CAT1 and arrange to send the marks and attendance details to the parents on or before 27<sup>th</sup> November 2024, through the tutors.

**3. Graduation Day:**

Graduation day is scheduled on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2024 (Saturday) at 10am for 2023 passed out students. HoDs are requested to provide the count of students and parents to the registrar on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2024 (Friday), evening.



**4. NBA Pre-qualifier Submission:**

**5. Status Update on Laboratory facilities:**

**6. Classroom Arrangement:**

**7. International Conference Website:**

**8. Research Conclave:**

Research conclave is scheduled to be conducted in May 2025. Best papers will be given cash prize. Research scholars are to be motivated to present their research papers in the research conclave. Selected papers will be published in Springer Book Series on Sustainable Economy and Ecotechnology.

**9. Olympiad and Spell Bee Contest:**

302 students participated in the Maths and Physics Olympiads. Meanwhile, 156 students took part in the first round of the Spell Bee contest, out of which 32 students have been shortlisted for the second round.

**10. Extra-Curricular Activities:**

All the first-year students are to be engaged in any one of the extra-curricular activities. Associate Dean (ECA) was requested to ensure.

**11. Library Usage:**

The status on the usage of the library was reviewed. ECE Department is utilizing this very well. HoDs are requested to motivate faculty and students to use library resources effectively.

**12. LaTeX Training:**

HoDs are requested to depute research scholars and one faculty member to attend the LaTeX training programme on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2024, by R&D team of TCE.

**13. Electric Fire:**

HoDs are requested to specify the number of fire extinguishers and posters needed on first aid measures for handling the accidents due to electric short circuits. The Dean (Infrastructure) will ensure their preparation and distribution.

**14. Removal of Chairs in the Corridor:**

The Principal advised to remove the chairs and tables in all the corridors of each block, for smooth flow.
