

The candidates will be informed, through email, of all the dates.

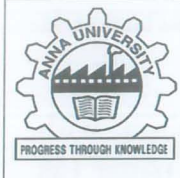

Kind attention is invited to the reference cited, wherein the Syndicate had permitted the Autonomous Colleges, affiliated to the University, to conduct examinations for the candidates those who have exhausted the maximum period as per their Regulations. The minutes of the Syndicate is given below for your perusal.

RESOLVED TO PERMIT the following categories of students who have exhausted the maximum time allowed to appear for their arrear examinations as a special case, for three attempts during August / September 2021, February 2022 and August 2022.

Category 1: Students of University Departments of Anna University, Chennai admitted in the Academic Year 1990 onwards (both UG & PG under Full Time & Part Time Mode).


Category 2: Students of Affiliated Colleges of Anna University and students Admitted in the affiliated colleges at the time of admission i.e. during Academic year 2001 (3rd semester onwards) & 2002 (1st semester onwards) and currently in Autonomous ones including Distant Education offered by Anna University.


RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the following conditions be followed towards the conduct of the examination:-

- 1) A special fee of Rs.5000/- shall be collected from the students along with normal examination fee, as prescribed by the University, for each paper (as approved earlier in the Syn. Res.No.241.20).
- 2) Examination be conducted in offline / online mode depending on the COVID-19 pandemic situation.
- 3) The O/o the Controller of Examinations / Additional Controller of Examinations (UD), Anna University and the O/o the Controller of Examinations of Autonomous Colleges have to provide facilities for the students' registration of subjects and mode of payment through online etc. for the smooth conduct of examination.
- 4) Examinations be conducted only for registered subjects - that are received by the office of the Controller of Examinations / Additional Controller of Examinations (UD), Anna University and the O/o the Controller of Examinations of Autonomous Colleges - on or before the schedule dates.
- 5) Based on the registration of subjects, the schedule of examination will be announced later.
- 6) **No further chance to appear in the examination will be given to the students in this category.**


I request you to publish all the instructions in connection with this examination in the official website of the Controller of Examinations of your college, as this is the last opportunity for these students.
