Vision, Mission, Program Educational Objectives, Program Outcomes and Scheduling of Courses

1. Credits for first semester can be reduced.
2. Credit equivalence with other universities is to be rechecked since there is a drastic reduction from 184 to 163.
3. Core papers of a particular discipline are to be given higher credits to emphasize its importance (Professional Communication and other department courses cannot have the same credit)
4. The scheduling of mathematical courses can be changed
 - a. Discrete Mathematics in 3rd semester;
 - b. Graph Theory and Combinatorics in 4th Semester;
 - c. Probability and Statistics in 5th Semester; Fuzzy Logic can be introduced as it is more relevant.
5. Transformations, Geometry, Linear Algebra, Calculus, and Differential Equations can be split between Engineering Mathematics I and II.
6. Higher secondary mathematics can be revisited as a Refresher/Bridge course.
7. Service Oriented Architecture can be moved in to the core.
8. Distributed systems should include Cloud Computing.
9. Software Testing can be added as a elective offered by special interest groups.
10. Specific Course on Entrepreneurship development should be added as the PEO on Entrepreneurship needs to be addressed.
11. Framework technologies like J2EE, .Net, OpenStack, Android Programming can be taken as one credit courses by industry.
