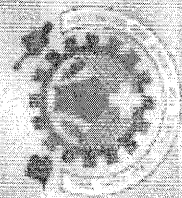

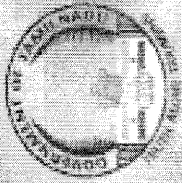

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am directed to inform that on the recommendations of the Expert Committee, UGC has selected you for the UGC Research Award for a period of two (2) years without undertaking any research guidance. However, in order to remain in touch with the latest developments in their respective areas of teaching and research, the awardees may take classes/teach in their place of work/institution of implementation of the Award, without any additional remuneration. This period of teaching is inclusive of the full tenure of the award.

The details of the scheme may be referred in the UGC Website www.ugc.ac.in. This award is also governed by the following terms & conditions:

During the period of award, the awardee will be paid full salary with admissible allowances which would be reimbursed to the Institution where the awardee is undertaking research except the CPF/GPF contributions, as the same is to be borne by the parent institution.

- Research grant to meet expenditure on books and journals chemicals and equipments for the entire period is as under:
Humanities and Social Sciences including languages : Rs. 2.00 lakh
Sciences/Natural Sciences/Engineering and Technology : Rs. 3.00 lakh
- The awardee, being on duty leave, shall continue to earn normal increment and maintain his/her seniority in the parent university/institution/college.
- He/She will be entitled to holidays and all other privileges as per his/her entitlement in the university/institute, including facilities of staff quarters/ medical assistance, etc. during the period of the award.
- Expenditure towards travel within the country in connection with research work has to be met out of the research grant only. No additional funds will be provided for this purpose.
- The expenditure towards engagement of any project assistant will have to be met out of research grant for a maximum amount of Rs. 5,000/- p.m. (consolidated) during the tenure of the award only. The tenure of the project assistant will be co-terminus with the Research Award.
- The Commission will not provide any grant towards the salary of the substitute, if appointed, in place of the awardee.

The awardee shall submit a mid-term progress report of the research work through the Head of Department as well as the Registrar of the University/Principal of the College on completion of 12 months from the date of joining.

On completion of the award, two copies of the final report of the project should be submitted by the awardee through Head of the Department to the UGC alongwith an abstract, clearance certificate (No dues), consolidated details of expenditure and audited Utilisation Certificate against the full grants sanctioned during his/her tenure.

In the consolidated report, the fellow must outline the objectives set forth and objectives achieved, alongwith possible application of the research output and names of user agency/organization and Industry that can take advantage of the research.

The awardee shall be facilitated to take up the award as early as possible but within a period of 45 days from the date of issue of the letter. The date from which the awardee would be able to join this award may be communicated to the Commission. The Joining Report in the prescribed proforma may be sent to the Commission through channel together with all the required documents.

The tenure of the fellowship is for five years and it commences w.e.f. 1.4. 2013 (or) from the date of Registration under M.Phil / Ph.D. (or) from the date of joining in M.Phil / Ph.D. programme, **whichever is later**. The other requirements and details of the Scheme is enclosed as **Annexure-I**. The summary of the financial assistance offered under the Scheme are as follows:

1.	Amount of Fellowship (For All Subjects)	@ Rs.16,000/- per month for initial two years (JRF), @ Rs.18,000/- per month for the remaining tenure (SRF)
2.	Contingency (For Humanities, Social Sciences and Commerce)	@ Rs.10,000/- per annum for initial two years, @ Rs.20,500/- per annum for remaining three years.
3.	Contingency (For Sciences and Engineering & Technology)	@ Rs.12,000/- per annum for initial two years, @ Rs.25,000/- per annum for remaining three years.
4.	Escorts / Reader Assistance	@ Rs.2,000/- per month in case of physically and visually challenged candidates.
5.	HRA	As per University / Institution rules.

The awardee is required to get admission and registration for **regular and full time M.Phil / Ph.D.** course in a University / Institution recognized by the UGC at first available opportunity **but not later than two years** from the date of issue of this award letter. Kindly note that this period is not extendable under circumstances. It may also be noted that the admission to M.Phil / Ph.D. should be taken by fulfilling the conditions of admission of the University / Institution concerned subject to the provision of the scheme as per advertisement of UGC.

It may be noted that the fellowship amount shall be disbursed through Bank to be identified/notified by Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The bank account of the awardee, (any bank) directly. The list of designated branches of Bank will be available on the ministry's portal. The awardee is required to approach the designated branch along with a Copy of the Award Letter and Joining Report with photograph, address and contact no. in the prescribed proforma. **Annexure-II**. The awardee is also required to submit the following documents to the designated branch of the Bank at the stipulated period interval:

1. At the end of every three months a 'Continuation Certificate' in the prescribed proforma. **Annexure-III**. This will make the awardee eligible to draw the fellowship for the next three months.
2. Half yearly submission of Progress report in the prescribed proforma **Annexure-IV** along with the 'Continuation Certificate'.
3. Details of the expenditure incurred out of the contingency grant to be submitted annually in the prescribed proforma. **Annexure-V**.
4. The claim towards HRA is subject to the submission of HRA certificate in the prescribed proforma **Annexure-VI**.
5. After the completion of two years of award of fellowship an 'Upgradation Certificate' need to be submitted in the prescribed proforma **Annexure-VII**.

Progress Report and Continuation Certificate.

It may be noted that UGC has proposed to link "AADHAAR" with student's bank accounts numbers so that there can be direct cash transfer and effect of the fellowship into the bank account of the student. In this regard Secretary, UGC has already requested to universities for helping the students for Aadhaar. Letter No.F.14-34/2011(CPP-II) dated 11-01-2013.

It may be noted that the award is liable to be cancelled and it will also attract legal action against the awardee in the following cases:

1. If the awardee is found to be ineligible to receive the award, at any point of time during the entire duration of the fellowship

2. Misconduct of Awardee

3. Lack of satisfactory progress of research work of the awardee

4. If the fellowship is drawn from other source(s).

5. On the basis of the evidence of facts and on any other ground of misconduct.
