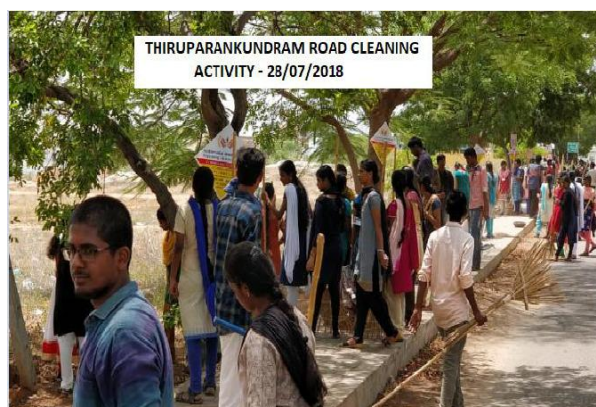
3. NSS CELL CLEANING ACTIVITY: - 11.08.2018
